### A Medium Sweeping

- Black tampico fibres
- Wire staple set into a natural hardwood block with two threaded handle holes
- Medium duty, non-brittle, natural fibre mix
- For general all-round sweeping
- Quickly sweeps up heavy dirt
- This well-filled brush will leave no residue

### B Medium Sweeping

- Black polypropylene fibres
- Well-filled staple set construction into a natural hardwood block with two threaded handle holes
- Long wearing .016 gauge polypropylene fibre will resist most solvents, greases, oils, acids and chemicals
- Ideal for indoor/outdoor, fine and medium sweeping
- Durable and economical
- Not affected by water
- Will not curl, load or mat

### C Coarse Sweeping

- Red synthetic fibres
- Wire staple set construction into a hardwood block with two threaded handle holes
- Stiff, durable .030 gauge polypropylene fibre is acid and solvent resistant
- An ideal indoor/outdoor broom for sweeping garages, asphalt, concrete, muddy or wet floors, as well as dry, heavily soiled areas

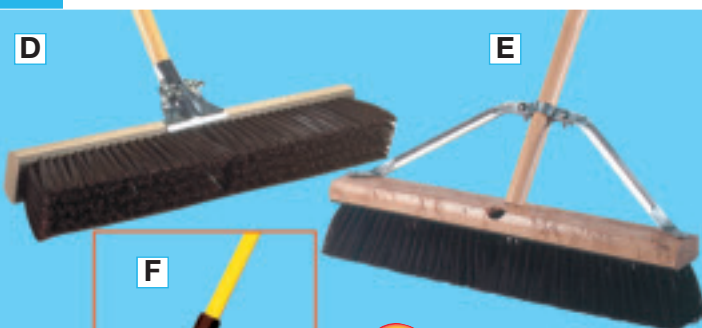
